



Parents Code of Conduct Agreement

The Board of Directors of Coastal Premier Field Hockey (CPFH) seeks to ensure that all CPFH games, tournaments and activities are fair, positive, and enjoyable experiences for all of the children and adults involved. Participation in Coastal Premier Field Hockey should be friendly and unifying -- a spirited social and instructional athletic occasion for players, coaches, umpires, and spectators. The mission of parents and spectators participating in the Coastal Premier Field Hockey League is to provide positive support and encouragement for their daughter participating in CPFH activities, and to ensure a sports environment that is safe, educational, and fun for all CPFH participants.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents' Code of Ethics:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, referees, and league volunteers at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child, and all other youth participants, ahead of my personal desire for my own child's personal success, or my desire to win
3. I will support the coaches' decisions, and if a problem should rise, agree to utilize the Coastal Premier Field Hockey recommended lines of communication to address any problems or issues that may arise.
4. I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics. I also will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, alcohol, abusive language and behavior and will refrain from the same at all CPFH events.
5. I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all. I will support my child, and instill in her to treat other players, coaches, spectators, referees, league officials, and other CPFH volunteers with respect. Respect should be afforded to all regardless of race, gender, creed, ability or team affiliation.
6. I will respect and instill in her to respect the property of Coastal Premier Field Hockey
7. I will help my daughter enjoy participating in Coastal Premier Field Hockey by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, field service and preparation, trash pickup, or volunteering my time where needed.
8. I will always do my part to ensure that all players have a safe and healthy environment in which to play. I will always remember that Coastal Premier Field Hockey is a youth sports organization, and the game is for the children, not the adults. I will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child.
9. I understand it is the policy of Coastal Premier Field Hockey that if a threat is made, the police will be called, and appropriate action will be taken under the laws of the State of Maine.
